Bridlington has two fabulous golden sand beaches either side of a picturesque, bustling harbour, where fishing boats bring in the day's catch and pleasure cruises leave for trips along the heritage coast. Discover the Old Town, where antique shops and art galleries will lure you, or head out to the 19th-century Sewerby Hall and Gardens (see right). In a dramatic clifftop position with spectacular views over Bridlington, the house and gardens are a sheer delight.

Go on a fascinating journey from coastlines to the ocean depths in this magical underwater world. There are also penguins, seals and otters.

Stroll along a gorgeous sweep of unspoilt beach, build a sandcastle or fly a kite, then head out to the famous Brigg for distant views out to sea and up and down the coast. It's terrific for bird watching.

**Filey Bird Garden & Animal Park**  
Get up close and personal with the animals here, from alpacas to zebu and giant rabbits to miniature ponies. Children love it there.

Jump on a number 14 bus in Bridlington (timetable is on the other side) to reach Flamborough and the pretty beach at North Landing flanked by stunning chalk cliffs backed by grassy hills. You could follow the footpath round to the clifftop landscapes of Flamborough Head with its famous white lighthouse built in 1806. Climb the 119 steps for stunning views out to sea. You can learn the history of the structure and how the lighthouse works. Check opening days online.

**Beachcomber**

Take a ride on Scarborough's fantastic open-top bus. This takes you from the South Bay right round the headland to North Bay, on to Alpamare Water Park and finishing at SEA LIFE. Your ticket lasts all day so hop on and off as you like. This runs up to every 20 minutes from April to the end of June, and up to every 15 minutes July to September. Get off route 13 buses at South Bay for easy connections.
