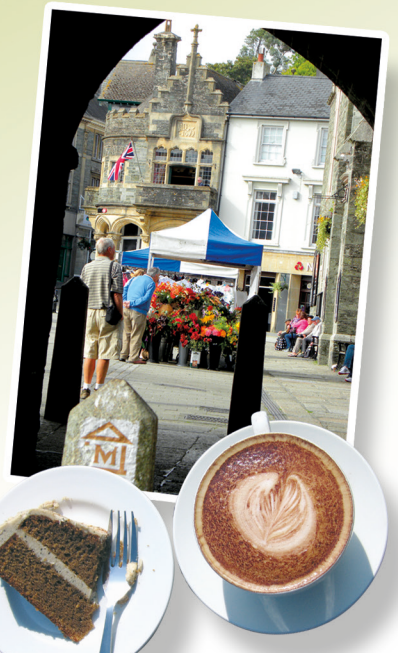

Look round the new **Guildhall Museum** and **Tavistock Museum**, explore the **Abbey** ruins or enjoy a tranquil canalside walk. Get a leaflet from the Visitor Centre and follow the Tavistock Heritage Walk.

Have coffee and cake in one of the independent cafés, or a cream tea or lunch at the Bedford Hotel.

Stirring stories are revealed at the **Prison Museum**. Afterwards, head to the **National Park Visitor centre** before treading in Sherlock Holmes' footsteps along the Hound of the Baskervilles Walk - allow up to 2 hours.
